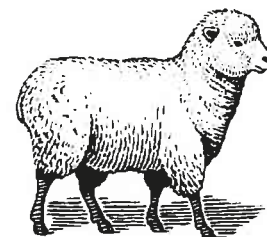

Notes

There is a special section for MV sheep. Forms will be inspected as exhibitors enter the sheep field. If there are fewer than 3 exhibitors in a section the class may be amalgamated with the Any Other Breed Classes.

All sheep entries must comply with any DEFRA regulations in force at the time of the Show.

All sheep must comply with any tail docking regulations.

All sheep cups to be presented after the interbreed judging in the sheep rings.

All cups should be signed for after presentation.

Would Exhibitors please ensure that they have entered for Special Prizes on the entry form.

Entry Fees: £2.50 per entry including group classes.

Show Members: £2.00 per entry including group classes

Prizes: 1st £12, 2nd £10, 3rd £8, 4th £6, 5th £4

(4th prize money will be awarded in classes of 5 entries or more) (5th prize money will be awarded in classes of 8 or more)
